**Tuesday Classes**

**7:00 PM – 8:00 PM**

**How We Got Our Bible – Dr. Patti Seawell, Instructor**

We will examine the ancient manuscripts, including the Dead Sea Scrolls. We will study what criteria the Church Fathers used to establish our Bible and why some were excluded. We will learn of those who gave their lives to translate the bible.

**Set Your House In Order (Stewardship in Action) – Helen Bellamy, JD and LaSaundra Wilson, JD, Instructor (2 Units)**

This course provides basic understanding of the principles of stewardship as applied to working with Powers of Attorneys, Advance Health Care Directives, Wills, and Trusts to prepare the individual for long-range planning. This is an introductory course that will provide the student with the working knowledge they need to make educated decisions.

**Church History II – Dr. Patti Seawell, Instructor**

We will examine the period of the Reformation beginning in the 1500's through modern times. We will focus on important figures of the past and learn lessons from their successes and failures.

**Theology VII: Spirit Beings and Last Things – Dr. Dorothy Rubin, Instructor**

This class covers the study of angels, demons, death, resurrection, judgment, heaven and hell.

**Family Matters – Pastor Gregory Colbert (2 Units)**

When God designed marriage it was designed to be the symbol of the greatest love every displayed. This course will cover Gods original purpose of marriage, the reasons Christian marriages are failing, the negative effect marriages are having on children and how we can take a righteous stand for marriages in the 21st century.

**Comparative Religions – Pastor Wayne Carroll, Instructor**

The student will become familiar with the major religions: Islam, Hinduism, Judaism, Taoism and why these faiths cannot save sinners from the wrath of God.

**The Book of Galatians – Dr. Brenda Stevenson, Instructor**

The central theme of Galatians is justification by faith. Paul defends that doctrine both in its theological and practical ramifications. He defends his Apostolic position against false teachers who attempt undermine his credibility with heretical teaching.

**Old Testament History III – Dr. Dorothy Rubin, Instructor**

This class is a study of the divided Kingdom prior to the Babylonian captivity. It also includes the majority of the prophetic Books and Messages which were written and given during that time.
